Explore the magnificent coastline along the Great Ocean Road and discover food and wine experiences of unparalleled quality in the heart of Victoria.

TWELVE APOSTLES LODGE WALK, GREAT OCEAN ROAD

Enjoy the variety of landscapes from coolclimate rainforest and remote beaches to coastal cliff tops, and finally view it all from the air on a Twelve Apostles scenic helicopter flight (included) on this 4 day, 3 night walk along Victoria's Great Ocean Road.

There are few better places to see Australian wildlife. The trail on the <u>Twelve Apostles Lodge Walk</u> is alive with native flora and fauna. Each night, accommodation is provided in eco-friendly, luxury villas where weary walkers enjoy daily foot spas then meals prepared by the internationally trained chef. Distance: 55km/34mi

- > Explore the Great Otway National Park and Port Campbell National Park.
- > Trek through forests of grasstrees and enjoy the ocean breeze.
- > Hear stories of shipwrecks and settlement, and visit remote untouched beaches.
- > Discover native birds, fur seals, wallabies, koalas, and many plant species unique to the region.



THE LAKE HOUSE, DAYLESFORD

Daylesford, located at the foothills of the Great Dividing Range, is a region famed for its high concentration of naturally occurring mineral springs and exquisite local produce. In the township there is much to explore and enjoy including day spas, restaurants, galleries, wineries, boutique shops, historic buildings and markets. Within a few minutes' walk south of the town centre you will find Lake Daylesford, perfect for a picnic or walk along its many walking tracks.

FOWLES WINE, STRATHBOGIE RANGES

Only 100 km north of Melbourne lies the Strathbogie Ranges. This highly diverse region incorporating farming land and forests, rocky outcrops, glades and waterfalls, produces distinctive wines from over 25 vineyards.

Fowles Wine

TAHBILK WINERY, NAGAMBIE LAKES

Venture 30 minutes north of Fowles Wine to the unique Nagambie Lakes region, one of Australia's premium viticultural regions. A picturesque area of tall, shady red river gums and views of the Goulburn River and surrounding wetlands.

Tahbilk Winery

Established in 1860 <u>Tahbilk</u> is one of Australia's most beautiful and historic family owned wineries. The property comprises some 1,214 hectares of rich river flats with 8 kilometres of permanent backwaters and creeks.

Tahbilk also boasts the world's largest, and some of the oldest, plantings of Marsanne as well as some of the world's oldest Shiraz vines.

- Wander amongst gardens, original buildings and underground cellars dating back to the 1860s
- Enjoy a tasting of Tahbilk's famous Marsanne at the cellar door overlooking the Goulburn River.

Pizzini Wines is a family-owned winery in the King Valley wine region of North East Victoria. Pizzini specialises in the production of Italian wine varieties such as Pinot Grigio, Arneis, Prosecco, Sangiovese and Nebbiolo.
