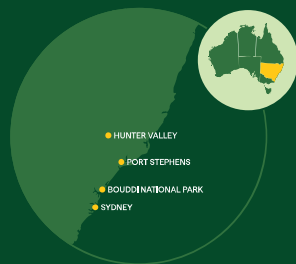

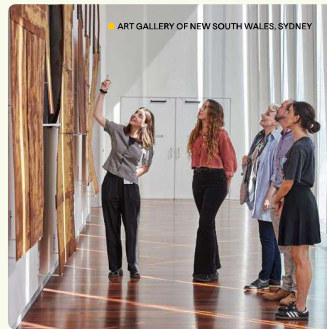

Afterwards, enjoy lunch at **Bistro Gadi**, the museum's rooftop café with sweeping city views.

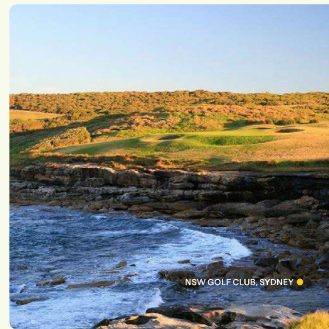

Day 3

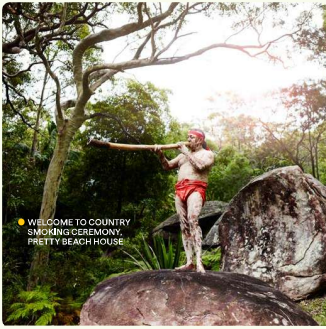
