VASSE FELIX

Vasse Felix was established in 1967 and is Margaret River's founding wine Estate. It is regarded as one of Australia's draw-card winery destination experiences and includes a restaurant, cellar door and art gallery.

Vasse Felix produced Margaret River's first Cabernet Sauvignon in 1972 and the wines maintain a reputation as regional and national benchmarks.
